

# Facility Vision Team meeting

**Purpose: To create a facility plan that allows for the design and development of flexible instructional learning environments that support student success now and after graduation.**

1. The team reviewed the research synopsis from Syracuse University, Information needed chart and the Educational Trends PPT from Kin and King Architects. They brainstormed what we still needed to do. It was determined that we needed the following:
  - a. Survey
    - Non-Likert scale (not 1-5) on redistricting, skills needed for college and employment, and the community schools concept
    - Openness to different configurations of elementary buildings
    - Education given to community before survey
  - b. Focus groups
    - Probably best after survey looking for an inventory of assets and diving into survey results
    - Gather data and information from focus groups to guide survey
  - c. Information
    - Live birth data and enrollment by primary zones
    - Impact of small elementary schools on student achievement- is too small problematic?
    - Data from schools that already have different programming and space usage
    - Connect OCS D programs and future plans so space fills need
    - Live tours of schools and virtual tours
    - Inventory of space
2. Planning survey- We decided that at our next meeting we would invite Thought Exchange to our meeting to begin creating survey questions. We also decided that we would launch and review results in February.
