In addition, the OHS Counseling Office hosts:

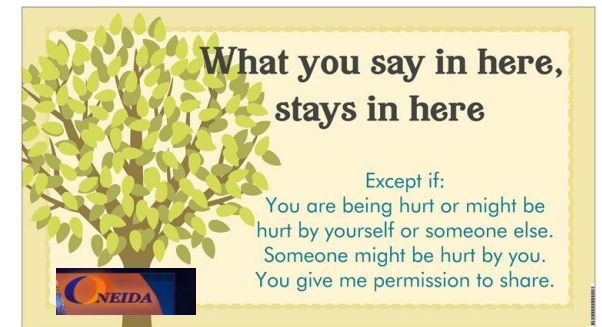
- The OHS annual College & Career Fair
